**Minutes**

On a motion offered by Amanda Miller, seconded by Linda Raymond, the February 22, 2017 minutes were approved, all in favor.

**Correspondence**

Dave Scranton shared a letter from New York State Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation that states that they have listed the property on Dollar Island on the New York State Register of Historic Places and have forwarded the nomination to the Keeper of the National Register of Historic Places in Washington, D.C. This board will be notified when the decision is made.

**LWRP**

Bruce O'Hara stated that the Arrowhead Park Project Advisory Board met on March 31, 2017. He shared notes from their meeting stating that the contract extension is good through October 31, 2018 and that the Town's remaining commitment is about \$125,000. There is \$60,000 in this year's budget towards this, and the rest will need to be budgeted for 2018.

The committee hopes to have all foundation work finished by Fall 2017, with decking, framing and final construction of the casino/boathouse building in Spring 2018, and full completion in time for 2018 summer events.

The proposed temporary vendor ordinance and permit application has been
