Minutes

LWRP

Bruce O'Hara reported that only one bid had been returned to the Town Board for the construction of the casino building. John Frey stated that this bid was turned down because it greatly exceeded the estimate. The Town Board is now considering hiring employees to complete the project, with hopes of having the foundation in and capped by Thanksgiving. It was also noted that the changing room addition is almost complete.

Sala Lot Line Adjustment

John Frey stated that the 30-day public comment period ends on October 12, which is two days after the town board's regular meeting. The town board will most likely wait until the November meeting to vote on it.

Snowmobile Trails

John Frey explained to the board that the town board is looking at a couple

alternate routes for the snowmobile trail between South Shore Road and Limekiln Road. They will continue to work with property owners on the lands between these roads to come up with the best solution for all and keeping the snowmobile trails open and accessible.

Parking

The board further discussed the parking issues that had been brought to their attention last month. Adele was asked to send a memo to the Highway Superintendent and the Town Board with suggestions to help improve parking in Inlet. See letter attached.

Fern Park

A meeting was held on Wednesday, September 13 to begin discussions about creating a master plan for Fern Park. Lynn Durkin volunteered to chair the committee moving forward. This meeting was well attended and a second meeting will be held on Thursday, September 28 at 7:00 p.m. in Inlet Town Hall. Anyone interested in the future of Fern Park is welcome to attend.
