

Public Hearing
Budget – 2018
Inlet Town Board
November 7, 2017

Present were John Townsend, Shawn Hansen, Lori Hansen

Officials present were Councilman Levi, Councilman Brownsell, Councilman Schmid, Supervisor Frey, Patty Wittmeyer, Town Clerk

The meeting began at 7:30pm with the Pledge of Allegiance. Hamilton County Snow and Ice agreement needed to be signed by both the Supervisor and the Highway Superintendent. The Supervisors' report for 2016 was discussed.

Public Hearing began with Supervisor Frey discussing line by line, the proposed budget for the Town. Increases in salaries of 2%, some were increased to reflect the current wage scale. Insurance and retirement costs increased. A revised pay scale for the Justices and the Assessor, was increased due to her education and passing of the state requirements.

Changes in the Police department concerning the proposed consolidation with Webb has increased the lines along with the new patrolman that is in training and Officer Lockyer receiving her waiver from the State.

The LWRP grant is in the final stages, finishing up on the proposed casino building putting in extra funds to accomplish this project. The need for new roofs on Cottages 2 & 3 puts extra funding in Parks. Revenues also increased with the rentals this season. Most of the other sections of the budget stayed the same. The increase for the General Fund came in at 4.83%.

Highway saw few changes, up 1.10% with salaries, increases in retirement and insurance. Fire/ambulance came in at .41%. Final increase overall will be 3.97% for 2018.

Having heard no more questions, the Board closed the Public Hearing.
