The Board met for a special meeting at 8:00am on Tuesday, Dec. 19.  
Officials present were Councilman Townsend, Councilman Levi, Councilman

The meeting was called to order, dispensing of the Pledge and began at 8:00am. The

2017.

On a motion offered by Supervisor Frey, seconded by Councilman Brownsell,  
the following resolution was ADOPTED by VOTE to appoint Herbert Schmid to fill  
the vacant seat on the Inlet Town Board and serve in this capacity until December  
31, 2017.

RESOLUTION NO: 77.17 DEPUTY SUPERVISOR

On a motion offered by Supervisor Frey, seconded by Councilman Levi, the  
following resolution was ADOPTED by VOTE to appoint Herbert Schmid as Deputy  
Supervisor to fill the term until December 31, 2017.

Other business to come before the Board was to decide on insurance coverage for  
employees hired halfway through the fiscal year. After some discussion, it was  
decided to cover the employee in full with the coverage and health savings plan,  
carried by the Town.

On a motion offered by Councilman Schmid, seconded by Councilman Levi,  
the following resolution was ADOPTED by VOTE to reimburse the employee only  
funds due during the employment of that person.
