Inlet Parks Department Report for June 2018

1. The staff had a hurried June with the late spring and bustle of spring events but were able to get the Parks, Cottages, and community Benches & Trash containers out to meet the needs of the visitors and businesses.
2. The pavers were moved to the grass portion of Arrowhead lakefront and will continue as more come in to the bathhouse rest rooms.
3. The Changing rooms are now in use and we hope our visitors will enjoy the new amenities we are offering.
4. The water on the Lakefront Beach was sampled and tested several times with Verona labs, but poor quality forced us to send a Sample to Ballston Spa, to CAN Labs for further testing. Even though the process left us with out an open beach during our first week of operation our Lab tests proved our water quality to be very good and the beach is now open for the summer season.
5. On July 12th a water sample will go out from the newly finished water fountain at Fern Park. This is a nice addition to our park and the Staff did a great job doing all the work in House. We would like to thank the Highway Dept. for digging us a short trench for the system.
6. The Docks as I write this are currently being taken down the channel to be skinned for fireworks for the fourth of July.
7. The Parks Department would like to extend the use of the lift rental again as we still have a good amount of work for it in the coming months.
8. With the Many events in July and summer crowds the work loads for a good half of the day watering plants cleaning bathrooms and taking in the trash, our time management for projects is a bit more difficult but we hope we can get a few more big projects off of the hit list.

Information Office Report

of the month June 2018

1. Balance in Petty Cash on June 30 was \$68.45.
2. From April 1, 2018 to June 30, 2018 this office has processed 0 snowmobile permits for the 2018/19 season. The Information Office will continue to sell 2018/19 Snowmobile Permits for the preseason rate of \$65 each until November 15, 2018. Permits can also be purchased at the Town of Webb Visitor Center and online at OldForgeNY.com. Stickers will be printed some time in September and will be then be mailed to anyone who has purchased one prior to printing. (During March, this office sold 75 permits for the 2018/19 season at the preseason rate of \$65. Old Forge sold 730.)
3. During the 2017 "Arts in the Park," \$2,480 was collected from 29 vendors to reserve 30 spaces (two also paid for additional space) for the 2018 "Arts in the Park". During the 2017 Fall Festival and up until September 30, \$1,280 was collected from 20 vendors to reserve 23 spaces for the 2018 Fall Festival. Since January 1st, we have collected an additional \$2,310 from 28 vendors to reserve 29 spaces for "Arts in the Park" (two are for one-day only) and \$335 from 12 vendors to reserve 12 spaces in Fall Festival. Applications and a list of vendors signed up can be found at www.inletartsinthepark.com and www.inletfallfestival.com.

Youth Commission programs & Arrowhead beach 2018

Currently, we have a returning baseball coach and a new assistant; a returning swim instructor and a returning swim assistant and a returning tennis instructor. Our number of participants is lower than usual. Old Forge was experiencing the same as of last week. Hopefully both of us will see and increase in our programs.

None of our previous years lifeguards returned to the beach. We are open 6 days a week from 11-3:00/3:30. Our beach attendant is also on the beach when it is open. We are still advertising. I have contacted TOW to see if any of their guards are interested in extra work when they are off. None have replied. There have been 3 certified lifeguards pick up applications that are currently employed at area camps. At this time, none have returned. Most are provided with housing and may have not been able to find a place to live. There have been a few uncertified persons interested. Currently we were not able to find a class for this season. Hopefully they will continue their interest and become certified before next season! Per New York State Dept of Health State Sanitary Code 6-2, we can operate with ONE guard for an area of 150' of beach. Arrowhead has 120' of buoyed area. This certified lifeguard can be 16 years of age. A 15 year old must have a supervisor present. The Town has always practiced 2 lifeguards at a time; unfortunately we do not have the work staff.
