Arrowhead Park Rest Rooms were refitted with new sinks and mirrors and opened to the public.

Arrowhead Cottages are open with water and heat cleaning anticipated this week.

Number three, cottage new roof project is complete & looks really great. Number two, cottage roof work will start Sept 1st and has been set to be unrented for the project.

The Fern Park Water Fountain Project Started on Wed June 6th.

Fern Park Softball field was given a good chunk of clean up time with new material being added and a new home plate installed.

The Paver Project is coming along nicely and we are ready for the concrete exit to the main dock.

Regular Parks Daily Maintenance has started with trash pick-ups mowing, field dragging, Rest room cleanings.

The new Lift on Rent to own is going back to ADMAR to have the breaks re done and a lift arm rewired.

The Parks Department replaced a push mower and a Pressure washer, the Push Mower owed us nothing was given to the Parks Dept. and ran 10 years. The Pressure Washer had seized up last season and we found a deal at Lowes.

Our Town Hall cleaning staffer should be back at Work on Sunday the 10th Of June.

Docks are set to go in during the week of June 11th for the summer season.

Information Office Report

of the month April 2018

1. Balance in Petty Cash on May 31 was \$69.91.
2. From April 1, 2018 to May 31, 2018 this office has processed 0 snowmobile permits for the 2018/19 season. The Information Office will continue to sell 2018/19 Snowmobile Permits for the preseason rate of \$65 each until November 15, 2018. Permits can also be purchased at the Town of Webb Visitor Center and online at OldForgeNY.com. Stickers will be printed some time in September and will be then be mailed to anyone who has purchased one prior to printing. (During March, this office sold 75 permits for the 2018/19 season at the preseason rate of \$65. Old Forge sold 730.)
3. During the 2017 "Arts in the Park," \$2,480 was collected from 29 vendors to reserve 30 spaces (two also paid for additional space) for the 2018 "Arts in the Park". During the 2017 Fall Festival and up until September 30, \$1,280 was collected from 20 vendors to reserve 23 spaces for the 2018 Fall Festival. Since January 1st, we have collected an additional \$1,655 from 20 vendors to reserve 21 spaces for "Arts in the Park" (one is for one-day only) and \$335 from 6 vendors to reserve 6 spaces in Fall Festival. Applications and a list of vendors signed up can be found at www.inletartsinthepark.com and www.inletfallfestival.com.

The June 5th meeting will be a bag stuffing event at Inlet Town Hall, and there will be no meetings in July or August. This group has lots of great ideas and is working well together.
