

RESOLUTION NO. 34.19  
PROHIBITING TRAILER PARKING SIXTH LAKE ROAD,  
TOWN OF INLET  
AUGUST 13, 2019

On a **motion** offered by Councilman John Townsend, **seconded** by Councilman Daniel Levi, the following resolution was **ADOPTED** –

AYES 5 NAYS 0

**WHEREAS**, The authority of a town to regulate motor vehicle traffic derives primarily from the Vehicle and Traffic Law (see also Town Law, §130[7]). The Vehicle and Traffic Law is applicable and uniform throughout the State, and prohibits municipalities from enacting conflicting local regulations, except as expressly authorized (Vehicle and Traffic Law, §1600).

**WHEREAS**, Article 41 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law (§§1660-1664) relates to the regulation of traffic by towns and grants authority to towns to adopt various traffic regulations. Section 1660 is a general enabling statute for towns, and details numerous traffic regulating actions a town is authorized to take.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, trailer parking on the Sixth Lake Road is hereby prohibited. The Town Board of the Town of Inlet authorizes Highway Superintendent to post marked signs showing such prohibition.
