

## ARROWHEAD PARK BEACH RULES - Updated July 14, 2020

- All beach patrons are encouraged to provide the beach monitor with a name and phone number or email for contact tracing.
- No group contact activities in the beach area or in the water.
- Patrons must maintain a 6' distance from others not in your group.
- If unable to maintain a 6' distance from others not in your group, an acceptable face covering must be worn.
- Face coverings must not be worn in the water.
- Only one patron on any ladder at any time.
- Only two patrons allowed on the floating dock at any time.
  - Unfortunately, because a few were unable to follow the rules, the floating dock had to be removed.
- Lifeguards and monitors reserve the right to limit the number of patrons on the beach.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Not allowed in beach area: diving, flipping, horseplay, tackling, dunking, inflatables, whistles, glass containers, animals, alcohol, drugs.
- Please stay inside the buoyed area.
- Please do not run on the docks.
- Please do not throw sand or rocks.
- Please do not disturb the wildlife.
- If you dig holes in the sand, please fill them in before you leave.
- On-duty lifeguards only allowed in lifeguard chairs.
- Area of ten feet from the water line and a path from the lifeguard chair to the water needs to be kept clear at all times.
