

Food Truck FACT Sheet

Why Food Trucks?

Due to a lack of walkable dining options in the downtown Inlet area, especially on the weekends during special events - like the Summer Concert Series - it has been suggested that the Town consider allowing food truck vendors on a trial basis to come set up at Arrowhead Park to service the needs of our visitors.

What is the Goal?

The goal of the food trucks would drive visitors to downtown Inlet as well as visitors from surrounding towns. Food trucks are a hot trend right now and we are looking to capitalize on them as a "tourist attraction" that will compliment with what we are already doing with the summer concerts.

How many food trucks? When?

Right now we are proposing allowing 2 food trucks to park over by the picnic area during the Summer Concert Series on Saturday nights only from 4PM - 9PM.

Are there costs to the Town?

Most of the food trucks are self contained.

It would be nice if we had electrical hook-up's for them - but not required.

Increased garbage in the park.

Inlet already checks garbage cans in the evenings after the concerts.

Administrative costs: We would require them to file for a permit and provide licensing and proper documentation.

Inlet would charge a fee (\$50/day proposed).

Requirements?

We would only invite food truck vendors that did not directly compete with any other business in town. For example, no pizza vendors.

We are thinking more along the lines of a BBQ vendor or Mexican.

Cannot park overnight. Once the concerts are over they need to vacate the park.
