

Inlet Town Board
Budget Meeting
September 19, 2017

This meeting was scheduled to begin discussions on the 2018 budget. All business to come before this Board, will also be heard.
The Town Clerk contacted the NYSDOT and asked about parking signs located in front of Post Offices'. She was told that a resolution was needed in order for DOT to move forward on this request.

RESOLUTION NO: 62.17 REQUEST FOR PARKING SIGNS

On a motion offered by Councilman Levi, seconded by Councilman Brownsell, the following resolution was ADOPTED by VOTE:

WHEREAS; the Town of Inlet Post Office is located on State Route 28, directly in the middle of the Town center, AND

WHEREAS; with the increasing number of Senior Citizens living in Inlet, visiting the Post Office daily, trying to park near the building, AND

WHEREAS; with parking, during the summer months at a premium, have led to many issues accessing the Post Office with their limited hours, AND

WHEREAS; the need for signage has become evident during certain times to accommodate all that use the Post Office, SO THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED; that NYS DOT Traffic and Safety, will allow parking signs with the following:

15 MINUTE PARKING
POST OFFICE PATRONS ONLY
MON-FRI 9:15-4:15
MEMORIAL DAY-LABOR DAY

To be placed in front of the Inlet Post Office as requested by the Town Board.

4 AYES 0 NAYS Motion carried

This resolution will now be sent to the Traffic and Safety division of DOT and we will wait to see what happens. Lines that could be placed in front of the Post Office was also discussed.

The Board also discussed the bid that was received for the LWRP project, concerning the casino building. They all felt it was much higher then anticipated and voted on the following.

RESOLUTION NO: 63.17 REJECTION OF BID

On a motion offered by Councilman Schmid, seconded by Councilman Brownsell, the following resolution was ADOPTED by VOTE to reject the bid received on 9/11/17 from Charles Gaetano Construction Company.

The Town may have to act as lead agent on this project, outsourcing the work with qualified workers, including in house employees.
