Codes & Zoning

The group briefly discussed the need for more parking in the downtown Inlet area, especially with two new restaurants opening up this summer. If each business with the property could dedicate 4 spaces behind their buildings for employees this would help. It was suggested to make sure the Inlet Town Board is aware there is a parking problem. It was also suggested that the Town consider an agreement with Inlet Community Church and Church of the Lakes like what is in place with the use and maintenance of the lots at St. Anthony's Church. It was also suggested to make improvements at Fern Park and for more parking along with better signage.

Codes and Zoning Update

It was noted that this board is still waiting for an update from the attorney's office on proposed changes to the short term rental ordinance.

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All business having come before this board, the meeting adjourned at 7:28 p.m. with a motion offered by Amanda Miller, seconded by Dennis Hudson.
