It was noted that there is a stop sign where the trail crosses the road by Mary's Gift Shop, and there are signs that say No Snowmobiles on Plowed Sidewalks in town and no signage that tells them it is "OK" to ride the sidewalk from Mary's to Inlet Town Hall. Some suggestions included more signage,

information shared with the open businesses, and not plowing the sidewalk in front of the closed businesses.
